

- ACCJC has been demanding faculty participation in SLOs and SLO assessment for several years now.
- Recent ACCJC standards have required colleges to include SLO participation on faculty evaluations.
- The new ACCJC President, Richard Winn, recently informed all colleges and districts about a proposal to eliminate this standard. (See attachment)
- ACCJC is proposing to eliminate the following—*The evaluation of faculty, academic administrators, and other personnel directly responsible for student learning includes, as a component of that evaluation, consideration of how these employees use the results of the assessment of learning outcomes to improve teaching and learning.*
- According to Richard Winn’s message, it appears that eliminating the standard requiring SLO participation as part of faculty evaluations will likely be approved January, 2018.
